

D. Temporary Signs Allowed Without a Permit - Non-Residential Zones

6. Portable Signs. One A-frame or portable sign is allowed per business under the following guidelines:
- The sign is entirely outside of roadways, on-site drive isles, landscape areas, or designated parking areas. The signs shall be located on the pedestrian areas abutting the business and within the extent of the business face (See Figure 57).
 - They shall not be closer than 30 horizontal feet to another commercial sign.
 - A 6 feet wide, through pedestrian zone on the existing hard-surface, shall be maintained around the sign and such sign shall not obstruct any pedestrian or wheelchair access from the sidewalk to any of the following:
 - transit stop areas,
 - designated disabled parking spaces,
 - disabled access ramps, or
 - building exits including fire escapes,
 - They shall not exceed 3.5 feet in height, nor be more than 2 feet wide and the copy on the sign shall not exceed 3 inches in height (See Figure 58).
 - Commercial Centers and tenants of such may not place portable signs within the public right-of-way.


