

Chapter 15.08 ZONING

Section 15.08.130 Determination of zone boundaries.

Where uncertainty exists with respect to the boundary of any zone, the following rules shall apply:

A. Where the indicated boundary on the zoning map is approximately a street, railroad, public right-of-way, alley, river, irrigation canal or other waterway, the center line of the street, railroad, right-of-way, alley, river, irrigation canal, and other waterway, shall be the zone boundary.

B. Where the indicated boundary is approximately a lot line, section line or quarter section line, the lot line, section line or quarter section line, shall be the zone boundary unless otherwise indicated.

C. Where land has not been subdivided into lots and/or blocks, the zone boundary shall be determined by the use of the scale measurement shown on the map unless otherwise indicated.

D. Where uncertainty continues to exist, the Board of Adjustment shall interpret the map. (Ord. 1-1985 § 1-13)
