

## [Chapter 16.21 SUPPLEMENTARY DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS.](#)

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### Section 16.21.30 Snow Storage in Public Right-of-Ways.

- (1) Retaining walls or cuts adjacent to roads shall have a ten (10) foot minimum setback from the edge of asphalt. When the road section has a slope of 1.5:1 or greater, the setback from the edge of asphalt shall be twenty (20) feet. Except for limited landscaping elements, any material or structure (temporary or permanent) that will hinder the removal of snow shall not be allowed in the snow storage area.
- (2) On downhill slopes adjacent to right-of-ways there shall be a ten (10) foot minimum clear area. If determined by the County Engineering Department that more than ten (10) feet is needed for a clear area, the decision will be made at preliminary approval. The snow storage area shall be shown on the county plat as a recorded easement and shall remain open and unobstructed. Except for limited landscaping elements, any material or structure (temporary or permanent) that will hinder the removal of snow shall not be allowed in the easement area.
