

10-15-5: FENCES FOR RECREATION USE:

- A. Maximum Height: On rear or interior side property lines, a chainlink fence may be erected to a height of twelve feet (12') for the purpose of enclosing a tennis court, swimming pool or other court game area. Said fence may not be located within the setback area of yards abutting a front or street side yard. (Ord. 2001-815-O, 12-17-2001, eff. 12-17-2001)
- B. Pools And Jacuzzis: An impassible fence of a minimum of five feet (5') in height, or as approved by the planning commission, shall be erected around all swimming pools, jacuzzis or other similar pools not otherwise enclosed or covered. (Ord. 2005-889-O, 10-3-2005)
- C. Ponds, Canals, Ditches ¹: Fences of a minimum of six feet (6') in height shall be erected around all ponds, canals or ditches, where, in the opinion of the planning commission, there is determined to be a potential hazard to the health and safety of surrounding areas. (Ord. 2001-815-O, 12-17-2001, eff. 12-17-2001)
