

23-17. Water and Sewage Requirements.

In all cases, where a proposed building or proposed use will involve the use of sewage facilities, and a public sewer is not available, and in all cases where a proposed supply of piped culinary water under pressure is not available, the sewage disposal and the domestic culinary water supply shall comply with requirements of the County Board of health and/or State Board of Health and the application for a building and Land Use Permit shall be accompanied by a certificate of approval from said Board of Health.

Building permits shall not be issued by the Building Inspector or County Official unless private water supply and private sewage disposal is approved in accordance with the above requirements.

Where a public sewer is not available, each dwelling unit or other permitted or conditional use requiring sanitary facilities shall occupy a land area of not less than 20,000 square feet except as otherwise allowed or required by the County Board of Health and or the State Board of Health. 4-83
