

CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH
ORDINANCE NO. 12-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.52.270 OF THE LOGAN
MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING EXCESSIVE NOISE AND POLLUTION:

WHEREAS, the state legislature has granted general welfare power to the City Council, independent, apart from, and in addition to, its specific grants of legislative authority, which enables the City of Logan to pass ordinances as are necessary and proper to provide for the safety and preserve the health, promote the prosperity, improve the peace and good order, comfort, and convenience of the City and its inhabitants, and for the protection of property in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the following ordinance is in the City's best interest;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

10.52.270: EXCESSIVE NOISE AND POLLUTION:

A. Every person operating or having control of a motor vehicle that is stopped, standing or parked within the city shall control the noise of the motor and muffler thereof so that at all times the noise level of such motor and muffler is less than eighty five (85) decibels measured at a distance of fifty feet (50') from such vehicle.

B. No person operating or having control of a vehicle shall permit the engine of such vehicle to operate for more than three (3) minutes while such vehicle is stationary except when the local temperature as reported by the United States weather bureau is below thirty five degrees Fahrenheit (35°F). This section does not apply to idling by on-duty police officers or firefighters as necessary for the performance of their official duties. This section does not apply to vehicles owned by the City of Logan as necessary to operate equipment in the performance of official duties.

SECTION 2: Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon publication.

LOGAN MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

The Municipal Council of the City of Logan Utah will hold public hearings to consider the following:

- Adoption of the 2011-2012 FM budget appropriations \$8,076 for funds received from the Justice Administration Grant (JAG). The award is being used to purchase software and other miscellaneous equipment and supplies for the Police Department; \$764 for the 911 Emergency Medical Services Grant.
- A proposed increase in the Weekend/Holiday Opening and Closing Excise Fee at the Logan City Cemetery.
- A proposed amendment to Section 2.24.070 of the Logan Municipal Code regarding Outside Employment; Corridor of Interest for the Logan City Police Department.
- A proposed amendment to Section 10.02.070 of the Logan Municipal Code regarding Executive Order 100 regarding the removal of city police officers and firefighters within the City of Logan.

Said public hearings will be held Tuesday, February 21, 2012, not before 5:30 p.m. in the Municipal Council Chambers, 200 North 100 West, Logan UT. Full texts of these resolutions are available for inspection at the City Recorder's Office during business hours.
