Section 15.04.750 Forms.

Forms shall be substantially built and adequately braced so as to withstand the liquid weight of concrete. All linings, studding, walling and bracing shall be such as to prevent bulging, spreading, or loss of true alignment while pouring and displacement of concrete while setting.

Metal forms shall be used for curb and gutter work except at curves. All edge forms for sidewalk pavements, curbs and gutter shall be of sufficient rigidity and adequately braced to accurately maintain line and grade.

Forms for curbed sections shall be so constructed and placed that the finished surface of walls and edge of sidewalks, curbs and gutters will not deviate appreciably from the arc of the curve.

Exposed vertical and horizontal edges of the concrete in structures shall be chamfered by the placing of moldings in the forms. (Ord. 5-1988 § 1 (part): Development Code 4-6-4)
