



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
Historical Population Counts: 1980-2000

From 1980 to 2000, the population has remained relatively steady.




Population by Selected Age Groups 1980-2000

Since 1980, the youth population of the Goshute Reservation have grown while the older populations have dropped.




Utah Population by Race: 2000

Census 2000 indicates that American Indian and Alaska Native made up 1.33% of the Utah population. Those selecting the "Some Other Race" category were primarily of Hispanic/Latino descent.



Employment (non-agricultural) by Major Industry


No single industry predominates the employment. Some industries are not given either due to a negligible employment number or in order to protect firm-specific data.



Class of Worker


Government workers includes all public-sector services, including schools, fire departments, and local government.


**Job Growth Rate: 1970-2000
Utah vs. Nation**

Since 1970, Utah has consistently outpaced the U.S. in the amount of job growth. Meaningful data on job growth for Reservations is not available.




**Unemployment: 1980-2002
Utah vs. Reservation**

From 1990-2000, there was a decrease in labor force participation. Data for the Goshute was only available for two censuses.




**Median Household Income: 1989 & 1999
Utah vs. Reservation**

From 1980-1990, there was an increase in median household income.



**Per Capita Income: 1989 & 1999
Utah vs. Reservation**


Per capita remained rose from \$1,780 in 1990 to \$8,054 in 2000, a 450% increase.



Note: 1989 income values have been adjusted to 1999 constant dollars by dividing 1989 dollar values by a deflator factor of 0.744298


**Population in Poverty
Utah vs. Reservation**

A large percentage of families and individuals are below the federal poverty guidelines. The most accurate numbers are the 2000 census, showing 37% of individuals in poverty.




Educational Attainment: 1990* Utah vs. Reservation

The percentage of those 25 years and over that graduated from high school or higher increased by 20% from 54% to 65% from 1990 to 2000.
