




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
**Historical Population Counts:
1980-2000**

From 1980 to 1990 the population living on reservation increased by 75% but decreased from 1990-2000, by 22%.




**Population by Selected Age Groups

The age of the population increased from 1980 to 1990, then decreased by 2000.




Utah Population by Race: 2000

Census 2000 indicates that American Indian and Alaska Native made up 1.33% of the Utah population. Those selecting the "Some Other Race" category were primarily of Hispanic/Latino descent.




Employment (non-agricultural) by Major Industry

Class of Worker


Government workers includes all public-sector services, including schools, fire departments, and local government.


**Job Growth Rate: 1970-2000
Utah vs. Nation**

Since 1970, Utah has consistently outpaced the U.S. in the amount of job growth. Meaningful data on job growth for Reservations is not available.




**Unemployment: 1980-2002

Labor force participation decreased from 1990 to 2000.




**Median Household Income: 1989 & 1999

Median household income decreased from 1990 to 2000.

Utah vs. Reservation**


Per capita income from 1990 to 2000 also decreased.



Note: 1989 income values have been adjusted to 1999 constant dollars by dividing 1989 dollar values by a deflator factor of 0.744298


**Population in Poverty
Utah vs. Reservation**

Poverty level rose from 40.7% of families living below the poverty line in 1990 to 55.9% in 2000.




Educational Attainment: 1990*
Utah vs. Reservation

The percentage of those 25 years or older with a high school diploma or greater increased from 1990. The percentage remained constant to 2000. The rate remained lower than the average for the State of Utah.

Utah vs. Reservation



*Educational attainment figures for the Sate of Utah are for the population 18 years and older, for the Tribes are 25 years and over.

**Data for the tribes only contain two categories: High School Graduate and College Bachelor's Degree. Figures for "Less than High School Graduate" are calculated from these values.
