




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
**Historical Population Counts:
1980-2000**

Population remained the same from 1990 to 2000.
The median age increased by 30% from 22 years to 28.5 years




**Population by Selected Age Groups

The Skull Valley Goshute population is aging.




Utah Population by Race: 2000

Census 2000 indicates that American Indian and Alaska Native made up 1.33% of the Utah population. Those selecting the "Some Other Race" category were primarily of Hispanic/Latino descent.

by Major Industry**


The Skull Valley Goshute are employed primarily in the government and information sectors. Some industries are not given either due to a negligible employment number or in order to protect firm-specific data.



Class of Worker


Government workers includes all public-sector services, including schools, fire departments, and local government.


**Job Growth Rate: 1970-2000
Utah vs. Nation**

Since 1970, Utah has consistently outpaced the U.S. in the amount of job growth. Meaningful data on job growth for Reservations is not available.




**Unemployment: 1980-2002
Utah vs. Reservation**

In 2000, 100% were in the labor force. In 1990, only 30% of those 16 years and older were in the labor force. Data for their reservation was only available for one census.




**Median Household Income: 1989 & 1999
Utah vs. Reservation**

Household income for the Skull Valley Goshute dropped in the 1990s, moving from above the state average to below.



**Per Capita Income: 1989 & 1999
Utah vs. Reservation**


Per capita income also dropped in the 1990s.



Note: 1989 income values have been adjusted to 1999 constant dollars by dividing 1989 dollar values by a deflator factor of 0.744298


**Population in Poverty
Utah vs. Reservation**

The number of individuals in poverty increased from 1990 to 2000, reflecting the drop in income.




Educational Attainment: 1990* Utah vs. Reservation

High school completion and college attendance rates are lower than the average for the State of Utah.



Educational Attainment: 2000 * Utah vs. Reservation

High school completion and college attendance rates among Native Americans are lower than the the average for the State of Utah.



*Educational attainment figures for the Sate of Utah are for the population 18 years and older, for the Tribes are 25 years and over.
